## Curriculum News

### Welcome Back!

### Literacy:

This week we will be celebrating Groundhog Day and practicing our literacy skills with fun groundhog activities. We will begin guided reading again this week while the children work on their literacy centers. The students at computers will get to use a really neat new program on the computers called "Big Universe!"

#### Writing:

We will begin "How To" stories this week!

Word Wall Words to Practice: I, a, am, the, like, is, me, to, my, see, and, at, can, go, an, look, come, on, you, it, here, said, it, play, we, and, will, up, for, he, she, was. When your child practices these high frequency words at home pay special attention to correct letter formation. Efficient letter formation is an important gift that we can gently, yet firmly help our kids to acquire in kindergarten.

Your child needs to be able to write and read these words in a snap automatically or "in a snap"!

**Social Studies:** This week we'll begin a new unit about "Change Over Time". Students will explore how people and the environment change over time, developing historical concepts of past, present, and future. We will begin this unit by exploring how we have changed from a baby to now.




Please remember to check the **GREEN ALLIGATOR** folder daily. Remove anything in the "Keep at Home" side and check the "Return to School" side for important notes/info.
